She loved to play BUNCO, cards, and dominoes with her friends and family. Most of all, she will be remembered for her love of God, family, and friends.

She is a daughter of the late Wilbur S. and Katherine B. Mohr. In addition to her parents Loretta is preceded in death by her husband Roy Campbell; two sisters, Margaret Thompson and Mary Elizabeth Mohr; two brothers, Jack Mohr and Pidge Mohr; and her nephew James "Bud" Thompson.
