Raymond McCulley passed away on January 29 at 9:27 pm, surrounded by his wife and children.

Raymond was born in Allegheny County, Virginia on October 29, 1946 to James and Gertrude McCulley. He graduated from Raceland High School. He was part of the Ram football team, and later was inducted into the Raceland Ram Hall of Fame. He served in the US Army during the Vietnam war.
