brothers, Danny, George along with multiple nieces, nephews whom he dearly loved and always looked forward to visiting.

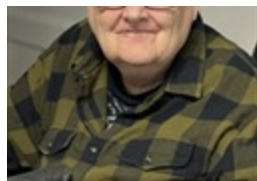
Russell will be deeply missed by all those who knew and loved him. His family find comfort in knowing he is now resting un the arms of Jesus.
